1 Day Geikie Gorge Experience



Highlights

Kimberley savannah, Fitzroy River, Geikie Gorge Dargku Aboriginal Heritage Cruise OR DEC Ranger Guided Cruise

Itinerary

Carved by nature, the dramatic Geikie Gorge lies between the ancient Geikie and Oscar Ranges. This day trip enables travellers to Broome the opportunity to experience one of the Kimberley's most impressive gorges in comfort. Cruise the waterways and learn of local Aboriginal legends and traditions relating to the gorge on the Dargku Heritage Cruise. Alternatively, opt for the Range Guided cruise for a geological and environmental perspective. The choice is yours.

Itinerary Updates

Departure

This trip departs on Tuesdays, and is subject to a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 20 travellers.
