# 1DWT

## 1 Day Windjana Gorge & Tunnel Creek



### Highlights

Gibb River Road, Derby Prison Tree, Windjana Gorge, Tunnel Creek

### Itinerary

Travel east from Broome for a day, heading into Kimberley cattle country via the Derby Prison Tree and the Gibb River Road. Spend the morning in the outback oasis of Windjana Gorge searching for freshwater crocodiles, local birdlife and Indigenous bush tucker, followed by an afternoon in the fascinating Tunnel Creek cave system. A swim in the waterhole is a highlight of the day. This day trip from Broome offers a glimpse of Australia's Kimberley region.

### Itinerary Updates

There are no itinerary updates to this trip since the brochure was printed.

### Departure

This trip departs on Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays and is subject to a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 20 travellers.

### Vehicles

This is a 4WD adventure and is operated with a comfortable 21

seat 4WD vehicle. All vehicles have airconditioning, reclining seats, PA systems and DVD players.

### FREE Hotel Pick Up

### Important Notes

- Please ensure you provide Kimberley Wild with a mobile phone number in case there are

any last minute notifications.

• Departures are all subject to weather conditions and road closures – this is usually only a concern for April & October / November departures.

• Tunnel Creek involves some climbing over rocks and wading through water by torchlight so a reasonable level of mobility is necessary to participate.

• Dinner is not included but can be purchased enroute back to Broome. Allow approx. \$20pp

### What else in Broome?

There is plenty to see and do in Broome but these are some of our favourite activities:

- A Taste of Broome town tour (½ day) – **approx AU\$129**
- Sunset Cable Beach Camel Ride (1 hour) – **approx AU\$55**
- Astro Tours Night Sky (2 hours) – **approx AU\$75**
- Sea Kayaking Adventure (3 hours) – **approx AU\$75**
- Willie Creek Pearl Farm (2 hours) – **approx AU\$80**

### What to Bring
