Itinerary

The Dampier Peninsula is one of the most spectacular coastal environments in Western Australia, and the perfect place to experience Indigenous culture in the Kimberley. Visit historical local communities, learn about local bush tucker, enjoy a taste of Indigenous Bardi lifestyle and relax on beautiful isolated beaches.

Day to Day...

Day 1 Beagle Bay, Kelk Creek Cultural Experience & Cape Leveque

Day 2 Cape Leveque, Lombadina Community & return to Broome

Itinerary Updates

There are no itinerary updates to this trip since the brochure was printed.

Departure

This trip departs on Saturdays and is subject to a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 20 travellers.

Vehicles

This is a 4WD adventure and is operated with a comfortable 21 seat 4WD vehicle. All vehicles have airconditioning, reclinable seats, PA systems and DVD players.

Accommodation

- Camping (1 night)

Please note...

- Camping involves tents (single/twinshare), swags with sheets & pillows with pillow cases.
- Sleeping bags are NOT included. 10°C sleeping bags are available for hire at AU\$20pp – these must be requested with our office prior to travel; we recommend that you bring an inner sheet.

Meals

This tour includes:

- Morning and Afternoon Tea
- 1 Breakfast
- 2 Lunches
- 1 Dinner

Our healthy meals feature fresh ingredients, gourmet salads and local Kimberley flavours. We cater for special dietary requirements where possible, so please advise us when booking.

FREE Hotel Pick Up

Kimberley Wild offers free pick up from your hotel, guesthouse or B&B in Broome, between 6.30am and 7.00am. Please advise us of where you are staying and remember to let us know if there are any changes.

We appreciate your patience if we are running a little late in the morning. You being there on time will help make sure we are! Call us on 9193 7778 if you are concerned that you have missed your pickup.

Important Notes

- This trip is the start of our 3 Day Cape Leveque Experience but travellers return to Broome on Day 2 with a Day Tour group – either Kimberley Wild Expeditions or an alternative operator.

- Please ensure you provide Kimberley Wild with a mobile phone number in case there are any last minute notifications.

- Departures are all subject to weather conditions and road closures – this is usually only a concern for April & October / November departures.

- Other optional activities on the peninsula include:

Mud Crabbing – **approx AU\$70**

Sea Kayaking – **approx AU\$70**

Glass Bottom Boat Ride – **approx \$100**

Whale Watching – **Jul to Oct**

Self-Guided Walks
Fishing – **handlines provided and bait available from Kooljaman**

- Space in the vehicle is limited so please keep your luggage light – bring only essentials in a small soft bag, max 10kg.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is highly recommended for all our trips. As we are travelling in a very remote area, you should ensure you are covered for medical expenses including emergency repatriation at a minimum. We strongly recommend that the policy also covers personal liability,

cancellation, curtailment and loss of luggage and personal effects.

Alcohol

Kimberley Wild Expeditions does not provide alcohol with meals. Travellers are welcome to bring a personal supply from Broome if desired – preferably no glass bottles. Please note that alcohol cannot be purchased en route – alcohol restrictions are in place throughout the Kimberley.

What else in Broome?

There is plenty to see and do in Broome but these are some of our favourite activities:

- A Taste of Broome town tour (½ day) – **approx AU\$139**
- Sunset Cable Beach Camel Ride (1 hour) – **approx AU\$55**
- Astro Tours Night Sky (2 hours) – **approx AU\$75**
- Sea Kayaking Adventure (3 hours) – **approx AU\$75**
- Willie Creek Pearl Farm (2 hours) – **approx AU\$80**

If any of these options inspire you, ask Kimberley Wild for more details.

What to Bring

Recommendations include:

- A broad-brimmed hat with sun visor for all round protection
- Swimming costume and towel
- Torch
- Sunscreen & Insect Repellent
- Walking shoes
- Long-sleeved cotton shirt (sun protection) and loose-fitting pants (warmth and insect protection for evenings)
- Warm jumper (particularly if travelling May-Aug)
- Personal water bottle
- Personal toiletries
- First aid (with any personal medication required)
- A sleeping bag (note that 10°C sleeping bags are available for hire at AU\$20pp – must be requested with our office prior to travel; an inner sheet is recommended).

Travel Tip

This trip is a great way to explore the spectacular coastline of the Dampier Peninsula, home of the Bardi saltwater people. But there is more! Consider joining Kimberley Wild for a complete Kimberley experience by combining Cape Leveque with an adventure into Kimberley Gorge country. Join our **5 Day Broome to the Bungles Bungles** (departs Tuesdays, Trip Code 5DBB) or upgrade to the complete **8 Day Spirit of the Kimberley** (departs Saturdays, Trip Code 8DSK). Alternatively, if you are short of time, consider simply adding a taste of the West Kimberley gorge country to your trip and take on the **2 Day Kimberley Gorges Escape** (departs Thursdays, Trip Code 2DGE) before joining this tour.
