8 Day Kimberley Adventure

Highlights

Kelk Creek, Cape Leveque, One Arm Point, Gibb River Road, Windjana Gorge, Tunnel Creek, Bell Gorge, Manning Falls, Adcock Gorge, Mt Barnett Station, Galvans Gorge

Itinerary

Explore the Kimberley wilderness, from the sea to the savannah. Roam remote pristine beaches, visit local indigenous communities, witness the tidal flows of King Sound and learn the secrets of the Bardi saltwater people before heading inland to immerse yourself in gorge country: walk to rugged gorges, bathe in waterfalls and lillie-laden pools, wade through the watery caverns of Tunnel Creek, encounter unusual wildlife and sleep under a canopy of Kimberley stars. This trip offers the chance to get close to nature in one of Australia's last wild frontiers.

Itinerary Updates

There are no itinerary updates to this trip since the brochure was printed.

Departure

This trip departs on Saturdays and is subject to a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 20 travellers.

Vehicles

This is a 4WD adventure and is operated with a comfortable 21 seat 4WD vehicle. All vehicles have airconditioning, reclining seats, PA systems and DVD players.

Accommodation

- Camping (5 nights)
- Hotel (2 nights)

Please note...

- Camping involves tents (single/twinshare), swags with sheets & pillows with pillow cases.
- Some camp sites are in designated National Park areas with basic ablution facilities.
- Sleeping bags are NOT included. 10°C sleeping bags are available for hire at AU\$20pp – these must be requested with our office prior to travel; we recommend that you bring an inner sheet.

Meals

This tour includes:

- Morning and Afternoon Tea
- 5 Breakfasts
- 7 Lunches
- 6 Dinners

Our healthy meals feature fresh ingredients, gourmet salads and local Kimberley flavours. We cater for special dietary requirements where possible, so please advise us when booking.

Meals NOT included are: dinner in Broome (Day 3), breakfast in Broome (Days 4 & 5) and lunch in Broome (Day 5) – these optional meals are at your own expense. Allow approximately AU\$120pp.

FREE Hotel Pick Up

Kimberley Wild offers free pick up from your hotel, guesthouse or B&B in Broome, between 6.30am and 7.00am. Please advise us of where you are staying and remember to let us know if there are any changes.

We appreciate your patience if we are running a little late in the morning. You being there on time will help make sure we are! Call us on 9193 7778 if you are concerned that you have missed your pickup.

Important Notes

- This trip is a combination of our 3 Day Cape Leveque Experience (3DIL) and our 4 Day Kimberley Gorges Safari (4DKS)
- Please ensure you provide Kimberley Wild with a mobile phone number in case there are any last minute notifications.
- This is a wilderness camping

adventure. There is a medium level of activity – walks and swimming – so you must be reasonably fit in order to participate in the itinerary.

- Departures are all subject to weather conditions and road closures – this is usually only a concern for April & October / November departures.
- Space in the vehicle is limited so please keep your luggage light – bring only essentials in a small soft bag, max 10kg.
- To participate in this trip you must be prepared to assist with preparing meals, cleaning dishes, collecting firewood, setting up and packing up camp.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is highly recommended for all our trips. As we are travelling in a very remote area, you should ensure you are covered for medical expenses including emergency repatriation at a minimum. We strongly recommend that the policy also covers personal liability, cancellation, curtailment and loss of luggage and personal effects.

Alcohol

Kimberley Wild Expeditions does not provide alcohol with meals. Travellers are welcome to bring a personal supply from Broome if desired – preferably no glass bottles. En route, alcohol can be purchased with meals only at Fitzroy Crossing. Please note that alcohol restrictions are in place throughout the Kimberley.

What else in Broome?

There is plenty to see and do in Broome but these are some of our favourite activities:

- A Taste of Broome town tour (½ day) – **approx AU\$139**
- Sunset Cable Beach Camel Ride (1 hour) – **approx AU\$75**
- Astro Tours Night Sky (2 hours) – **approx AU\$75**
- Sea Kayaking Adventure (3 hours) – **approx AU\$75**
- Willie Creek Pearl Farm (2 hours) – **approx AU\$80**

What to Bring

Travellers on this trip must bring a pair of shoes/sandals that you don't mind getting wet and a torch.

Other recommendations include:

- A broad-brimmed hat with sun visor for all round protection
- Swimming costume and towel
- Walking shoes
- Long-sleeved cotton shirt (sun protection) and loose-fitting pants (warmth and insect protection for evenings)
- Warm jumper (particularly if travelling May-Aug)
- Personal water bottle
- Personal toiletries
- First aid (with any personal medication required)
- A sleeping bag (note that 10°C sleeping bags are available for hire at AU\$20pp – must be requested with our office prior to travel; an inner sheet is recommended).



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
